



# 2017 Government-in-Action Youth Tour

Austin, Texas • Washington, DC

June 7th-16th, 2017



Students selected for this opportunity join more than 100 of their peers from Texas and another 1,700 from across the U.S. on this trip of a lifetime. Inspired by Lyndon B. Johnson's desire to give youths insight into national government, Youth Tour expands participants' horizons while educating them about government and cooperatives. Electric cooperatives in Texas have participated in Youth Tour since 1965. Deep East Texas EC has sent students since 2014. Deep East Texas EC will send 2 students on the 2017 Youth Tour, scheduled for June 7th – 16th.

The trip starts with a day in Austin, where students begin by touring the Texas State Capitol, Capitol Visitors Center, Bob Bullock Texas State History Museum and Texas State Cemetery. Activities include seeing a show at the Bullock IMAX and Texas Spirit Theater and dining at the famous food trailers in South Austin.

Once in Washington, students partake in guided tours of historic sites, museums and congressional offices, where they meet with their U.S. representatives. Entertainment opportunities on the trip include seeing a performance at the Kennedy Center and going on a dinner and dancing cruise on the Potomac River. Participants also attend Youth Day, hosted by the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association, for a day of learning and inspiration.

## **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Current high school sophomore or junior who live in the Cooperative's service area and whose parent or guardian is an active member receiving service from Deep East Texas Electric Cooperative, Inc.
- Application must include:
  - Two (2) letters of recommendation from two of applicant's current teachers.
  - Copy of your high school transcript.
  - Signature of both applicant and parent/guardian.

**Application must be postmarked or emailed no later than February 17, 2017.**
